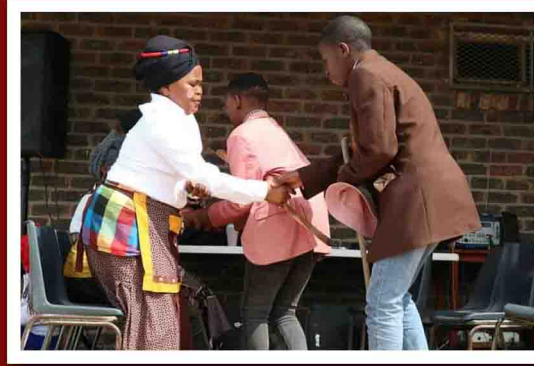

JUNIOR FOOTBALL FESTIVAL CIRCUIT





The newly structured and independent football federation, the Community Football Federation, is planning to launch its junior structure in 2025.

Moving away from the traditional League format where teams travel to opponents venue for a match, the CFF will remodel the traditional and implement the Junior Football Festival Circuit.

THE CIRCUIT

The JFFC is divided into age groups of u8, u10, u12, u14 and u16 (boys and girls). Boys and girls will be allowed to participate together in teams in u8 and u10.

The Competition season will be scheduled across tournaments hosted around Overberg in participating towns. These tournaments will be sub-divided into four competitions of Trophy, Shield, Plate and Bowl. Each team will participate in four (4) matches during the day and always be in some competition irrespective of any results.



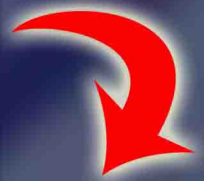
THE TOURNAMENT

All teams will be drawn into the TROPHY section. The winners of the matches will continue to play for the Tournament TROPHY competition. The losers fall into the PLATE competition.

The TROPHY and PLATE will then play quarterfinals for the respective competitions.

The losers of the TROPHY will then compete for the SHIELD; losers in the PLATE will compete for the BOWL.

The respective semi finals winners will continue toward the competition finals, and the losers to the 3rd/4th playoff.



THE COMPETITION

Points will be allocated to the teams in their final positions of the competitions they played in. These points contribute to their overall season competition after the culmination of the tournaments.
