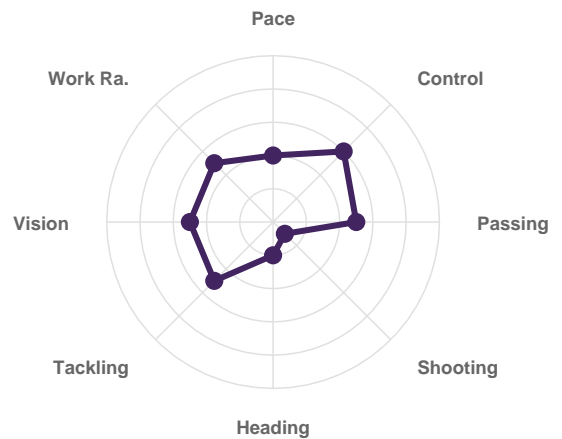

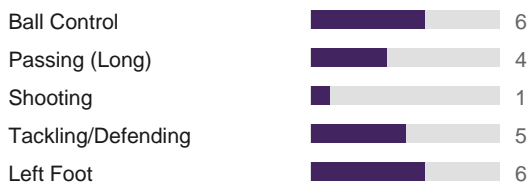

6V6 POSSESSION GAMES (20x20 GRID): Focusing on immediate reaction to pressure and maintaining possession integrity.

SCOUT'S ANALYSIS

Strengths

Game Intelligence: Reads danger early and anticipates play effectively (high interception rate observed).

Defensive Organisation: Vocal, organised, and provides structure to the back line.

Body Orientation: Uses half-turn well to receive and play forward.

Transition Play: Positive mindset to move play forward quickly after regaining possession.

Consistency: Proven impact across multiple tournaments.

Areas for Improvement

Scanning: Needs more frequent pre-receive checks to improve awareness under pressure.

Weak Foot: Heavy reliance on left foot reduces effectiveness in tight situations.

Composure Under Pressure: Occasionally receives flat-footed when pressed.

Development Recommendations

Scanning Habits: Introduce "scan–receive–play" routines in all training scenarios.

Weak Foot Training: Daily right-foot repetition (passing, control, short distribution).

Playing Out Under Pressure: Situational drills to improve decision-making and body positioning.

Additional Comments

Imange has set a high benchmark for defensive performance within the JFFC environment. His ability to read the game, organise defensively, and contribute to transitions makes him a highly promising centre back.

With improvements in scanning consistency and right-foot development, he has the potential to progress beyond his current level.
